Marriage Moments –

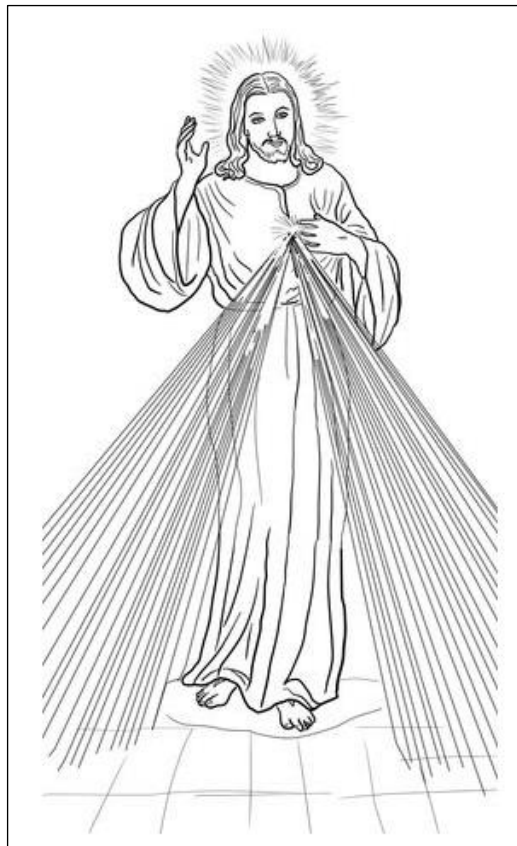
“Whoever fails to love does not know God, because God is love.” 1 John 4:8
